I read the revised manuscript and all reviewers' reports which were positive to the manuscript although they all requested a minor revision. The authors did not highlight their corrections, which made me harder to find out their corrections.

Overall, the authors did follow their comments to revise the paper. In my view of point, this paper is fine and is publishable. Before the paper can be accepted for publication, I request a minor revision.

The size of abstract is too long. The current size is 289 in the revision. The authors need to cut the size to maximum 200 words.

In addition, the abstract should not be the first section. The first section should be the introduction section. The authors need to separate them (abstract and introduction).

Moreover, the authors should move those keywords (Baganda people, Indigenous Knowledge and Natural Conservation aspects.) right after the abstract but before the first section (introduction section).

After the authors revise the paper by following my request, the paper should be able to be published.
